A typical Hand in Hand class (1 hr. 15 min.) includes:

- A presentation of the designated story (acting, movie, reading, puppets, etc.)
- Activities, Games and/or Crafts relating to the story/topic
- Small group Joys/Challenges sharing, and prayer time
- Discussion of the daily 'RISE!' readings (Encourage reading at home)
- Occasionally a snack may be served if it has purpose in the lesson

Other things to expect:

- Children are dismissed promptly at 8:00 pm. Please meet them inside the front doors of the church.
- The last night of a 'Set' is often a board game night. Children are welcome to bring a favorite board game from home, or use those we already have. While the Bible story may be excluded from the evening, the daily reading discussion and the prayer time is not.
- The final date of 'Set 3' will be determined partially by the date of the St. Matthew Spring Musical, and partially by the children's choir schedule/final rehearsal. Participants will be notified in advance if the schedule changes.
